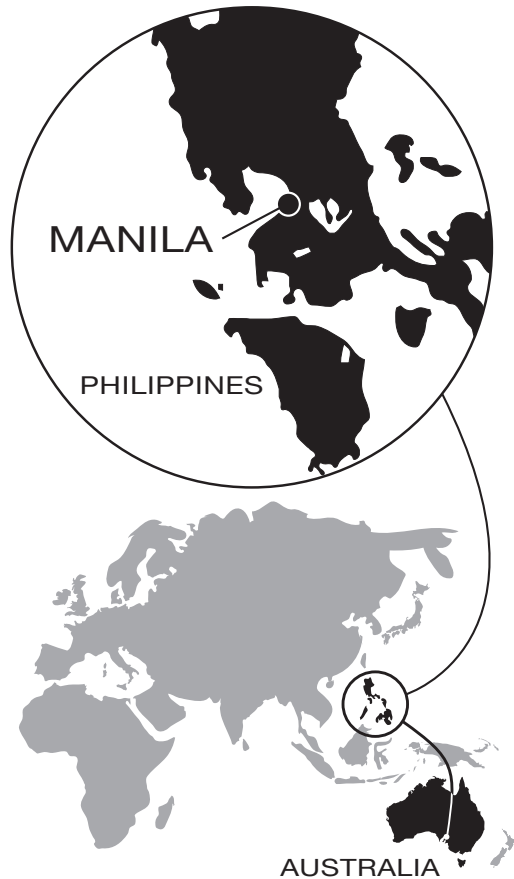




# Doing Business in the Philippines
